The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Labor

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to occupations; modifying regulation of barbers and barbering schools;  
1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2006, sections 154.065, subdivision 2; 154.07,  
1.4 by adding a subdivision; repealing Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 154.07,  
1.5 subdivision 5.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 154.065, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.8 Subd. 2. **Qualifications.** A person is qualified to receive a certificate of registration  
1.9 as an instructor of barbering who:

1.10 (1) is a graduate from an approved high school, or its equivalent, as determined by  
1.11 examination by the Department of Education;

1.12 (2) has ~~qualified for a teacher's or instructor's vocational certificate~~ successfully  
1.13 completed at least 38 hours of training in a program or programs approved by the board and  
1.14 that will provide the knowledge and skills necessary to instruct in the field of barbering;

1.15 (3) ~~has at least three years experience as is currently~~ is currently a registered barber in this state;  
1.16 ~~or its equivalent as determined by the board~~ with at least 1,400 hours of experience as  
1.17 a registered barber; and

1.18 (4) has passed an examination conducted by the board to determine fitness to  
1.19 instruct in barbering.

1.20 A certificate of registration under this section is provisional until a teacher's or  
1.21 instructor's vocational certificate has been issued by the Department of Education. A  
1.22 provisional certificate of registration is valid for 30 days and is not renewable.

1.23 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 154.07, is amended by adding a subdivision  
1.24 to read:

2.1            Subd. 7. **Transfer students.** When a student has paid or made arrangement to pay  
2.2 all applicable tuition fees to a barbering school, that school shall certify a student's hours  
2.3 to another school within ten days of the student's written request. The former school may  
2.4 charge a nominal fee for providing this certification and transfer of hours.

2.6            Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 154.07, subdivision 5, is repealed.
