1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to game and fish; adding trapping to the small game and sporting lifetime
1.3 licenses; amending Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 97A.473, subdivisions 3, 5.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 97A.473, subdivision 3, is amended to
1.6 read:

1.7 Subd. 3. **Lifetime small game hunting license; fee.** (a) A resident lifetime small
1.8 game hunting license authorizes a person to hunt and trap small game in the state. The
1.9 license authorizes those hunting and trapping activities authorized by the annual resident
1.10 small game hunting ~~license~~ and trapping licenses. The license does not include a turkey
1.11 stamp validation or any other hunting stamps required by law.

1.12 (b) The fees for a resident lifetime small game hunting license are:

- 1.13 (1) age 3 and under, \$217;
- 1.14 (2) age 4 to age 15, \$290;
- 1.15 (3) age 16 to age 50, \$363; and
- 1.16 (4) age 51 and over, \$213.

1.17 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 97A.473, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.18 Subd. 5. **Lifetime sporting license; fee.** (a) A resident lifetime sporting license
1.19 authorizes a person to take fish by angling and hunt and trap small game in the state.
1.20 The license authorizes those activities authorized by the annual resident angling and
1.21 resident small game hunting, and resident trapping licenses. The license does not include
1.22 a trout and salmon stamp validation, a turkey stamp validation, or any other hunting
1.23 stamps required by law.

- 2.1 (b) The fees for a resident lifetime sporting license are:
- 2.2 (1) age 3 and under, \$357;
- 2.3 (2) age 4 to age 15, \$480;
- 2.4 (3) age 16 to age 50, \$613; and
- 2.5 (4) age 51 and over, \$413.
