The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Labor

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to insurance; no-fault auto; regulating benefit terminations or denials;  
1.3 proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 65B.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **[65B.565] BENEFIT TERMINATIONS OR DENIALS;**  
1.6 **ARBITRATION.**

1.7 No reparation obligor shall terminate basic economic loss benefits or deny a claim  
1.8 by an insured for basic economic loss benefits unless this action is taken based on an  
1.9 award obtained in an arbitration proceeding pursuant to section 65B.525.

1.10 Sec. 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION.**

1.11 Section 1 is effective August 1, 2007, and applies to basic economic benefits claims  
1.12 arising from incidents occurring on or after that date.
