1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to public safety; increasing the appropriation to the Peace Officer  
1.3 Standards and Training Board; amending Laws 2005, chapter 136, article 1,  
1.4 section 10.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Laws 2005, chapter 136, article 1, section 10, is amended to read:

1.7	<b>Sec. 10. PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS</b>	<del>4,154,000</del>	<del>4,014,000</del>
1.8	<b>AND TRAINING BOARD (POST)</b>	<u>6,554,000</u>	<u>6,554,000</u>

1.9 **EXCESS AMOUNTS TRANSFERRED.**

1.10 This appropriation is from the peace officer  
1.11 training account in the special revenue fund.

1.12 Any new receipts credited to that account  
1.13 in the first year in excess of ~~\$4,154,000~~

1.14 \$6,554,000 must be transferred and credited  
1.15 to the general fund. Any new receipts

1.16 credited to that account in the second year  
1.17 in excess of ~~\$4,014,000~~ \$6,414,000 must be

1.18 transferred and credited to the general fund.

1.19 **TECHNOLOGY IMPROVEMENTS.**

1.20 \$140,000 the first year is for technology  
1.21 improvements.

1.22 **PEACE OFFICER TRAINING**

1.23 **REIMBURSEMENT. ~~\$2,909,000~~**

1.24 \$5,309,000 each year is for reimbursements
