1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 161.115, subdivision 76, is amended to

1.8 Subd. 76. **Route No. 145.** Beginning at a point on or near Route No. 10 at or
1.9 near Willmar, thence extending in a westerly direction to a point on Route No. 144 as
1.10 herein established.

1.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

1.12 Sec. 2. **LEGISLATIVE ROUTE NO. 262 REMOVED; REPEALER, EFFECTIVE**
1.13 **DATE, REVISOR INSTRUCTION.**

1.14 (a) Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 161.115, subdivision 193, is repealed effective
1.15 the day after the commissioner of transportation receives a copy of the agreement between
1.16 the commissioner and Martin County to transfer jurisdiction of Legislative Route No. 262
1.17 and notifies the revisor of statutes under paragraph (b).

1.18 (b) The revisor of statutes shall delete the route identified in paragraph (a) from
1.19 Minnesota Statutes when the commissioner of transportation sends notice to the revisor in
1.20 writing that the conditions required to transfer the route are satisfied.
