

2.1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota that it urges Congress to
2.2 timely reauthorize the State Children's Health Insurance Program to ensure continued State
2.3 Children's Health Insurance Program funding for the state.

2.4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature urges the governor to use his best
2.5 efforts to work with the Minnesota delegation to ensure that the State Children's Health Insurance
2.6 Program is reauthorized in a timely manner.

2.7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature proclaims that all components of state
2.8 government should work together with educators, health care providers, and social workers to
2.9 ensure that all available public and private assistance for providing health benefits to uninsured
2.10 families in this state be used to the maximum extent possible.

2.11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature urges the governor to use his best
2.12 efforts to provide meaningful assistance to help identify and enroll children and parents who
2.13 qualify for medical assistance or the MinnesotaCare program and are eligible for State Children's
2.14 Health Insurance Program funding.

2.15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota is
2.16 directed to prepare copies of this memorial and transmit them to the President of the United States,
2.17 the President and the Secretary of the United States Senate, the Speaker and the Clerk of the United
2.18 States House of Representatives, and Minnesota's Senators and Representatives in Congress.
