1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 168.011, subdivision 22, is amended to
1.6 read:

1.7 Subd. 22. **Special mobile equipment.** "Special mobile equipment" means every
1.8 vehicle not designed or used primarily for the transportation of persons or property
1.9 and only incidentally operated or moved over a highway, including but not limited to:
1.10 ditch-digging apparatuses, moving dollies, pump hoists and other water well-drilling
1.11 equipment registered under chapter 103I, vehicle-mounted concrete pumps with or
1.12 without placement booms, street-sweeping vehicles, and other machinery such as
1.13 asphalt spreaders, bituminous mixers, bucket loaders, tractors other than truck-tractors,
1.14 ditchers, leveling graders, finishing machines, motor graders, road rollers, scarifiers,
1.15 truck-mounted log loaders, earth-moving carryalls, scrapers, power shovels, draglines,
1.16 self-propelled cranes, and earth-moving equipment. The term does not include travel
1.17 trailers, dump trucks, truck-mounted transit mixers, truck-mounted feed grinders, or other
1.18 motor vehicles designed for the transportation of persons or property to which machinery
1.19 has been attached.
