

2.1 Subd. 3. **Labeling.** Drugs or medicine subject to this section, except
2.2 physician-prescribed and labeled naturopathic medicine, must be in a container with a
2.3 label prepared by a pharmacist according to section 151.212 and applicable rules.

2.4 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

2.5 Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 121A.22, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

2.6 Subd. 4. **Administration.** (a) Drugs and medicine subject to this section, except
2.7 physician-prescribed naturopathic medicine, must be administered in a manner consistent
2.8 with instructions on the label. Physician-prescribed naturopathic medicine must be
2.9 administered according to the order of the prescribing physician.

2.10 (b) Drugs and medicine subject to this section must be administered, to the extent
2.11 possible, according to school board procedures that must be developed in consultation:

2.12 (1) with a school nurse, in a district that employs a school nurse;

2.13 (2) with a licensed school nurse, in a district that employs a licensed school nurse;

2.14 (3) with a public or private health or health-related organization, in a district that
2.15 contracts with a public or private health or health-related organization, according to
2.16 section 121A.21; or

2.17 (4) with the appropriate party, in a district that has an arrangement approved by the
2.18 commissioner of education, according to section 121A.21.

2.19 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
