Committee Recommendation and Adoption of Report:

Re-referred to the Committee on Finance without further recommendation

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to human services; authorizing the licensure of two intermediate care
1.3 facilities for persons with developmental disabilities to replace one larger facility;
1.4 establishing the payment rate for the new facilities; appropriating money;
1.5 proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 252.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. **[252.295] LICENSING EXCEPTION.**

1.8 Notwithstanding section 252.294, the commissioner may license two six-bed, level
1.9 B intermediate care facilities for persons with developmental disabilities to replace a
1.10 15-bed level A facility in Minneapolis that is not accessible to disabled persons. The
1.11 new facilities must be accessible to disabled persons and must be located on a different
1.12 site or sites in Hennepin County. Notwithstanding section 256B.5012, the payment rate
1.13 at the new facilities is \$200.47.

1.14 Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATION.**

1.15 \$..... is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of human services
1.16 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, for the purposes of section 1.
