1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. TITLE.

1.8 This act may be cited as the "Minnesota Fishing Protection Act."

1.9 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 114D.45, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.10 Subd. 2. **Sources of revenue.** The following revenues must be deposited in the  
1.11 clean water legacy account:

1.12 (1) money transferred to the account;

1.13 (2) lottery revenues credited to the account under section 349A.10, subdivision 5; and

1.14 ~~(2)~~ (3) interest accrued on the account.

1.15 Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 349A.10, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.16 Subd. 5. **Deposit of net proceeds.** Within 30 days after the end of each month, the  
1.17 director shall deposit in the state treasury the net proceeds of the lottery, which is the  
1.18 balance in the lottery fund after transfers to the lottery prize fund and credits to the lottery  
1.19 operations account. Of the net proceeds, 40 percent must be credited to the Minnesota  
1.20 environment and natural resources trust fund and the remainder must be credited to the  
1.21 ~~general~~ clean water legacy account in the environmental fund.

1.22 Sec. 4. APPROPRIATIONS.

2.1            Subdivision 1. **General provisions.** The appropriations in this section are from the  
2.2 environmental fund and are available for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2008, and June  
2.3 30, 2009. Unless otherwise specified in this section, these appropriations do not cancel  
2.4 and remain available until June 30, 2009.

2.5            Subd. 2. **Pollution Control Agency.** The following amounts are appropriated to the  
2.6 commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency for the purposes stated:

2.7            (1) \$..... is for statewide assessment of surface water quality and trends. Up  
2.8 to \$..... of this appropriation is available for grants to support citizen monitoring of  
2.9 surface waters; and

2.10           (2) \$..... is to develop TMDL's for waters listed on the U.S. EPA-approved 2004  
2.11 impaired waters list.

2.12           Subd. 3. **Department of Agriculture.** \$..... is appropriated to the commissioner of  
2.13 agriculture for the purposes of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 114D.

2.14           Subd. 4. **Board of Water and Soil Resources.** \$..... is appropriated to the Board  
2.15 of Water and Soil Resources for the purposes of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 114D.

2.16           Subd. 5. **Department of Natural Resources.** \$..... is appropriated to the  
2.17 commissioner of natural resources for the purposes of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 114D.

2.18           Subd. 6. **Public Facilities Authority.** \$..... is appropriated to the Public Facilities  
2.19 Authority. Of this amount, \$..... is to the clean water legacy capital improvement account  
2.20 for grants under Minnesota Statutes, section 446A.074, and \$..... is to the water pollution  
2.21 control revolving fund under Minnesota Statutes, section 446A.07, for wastewater  
2.22 treatment and storm water projects. Funds appropriated under this subdivision do not  
2.23 cancel and are available until expended.
