1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to game and fish; modifying deer hunting license fees for nonresident
1.3 youth; amending Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 97A.451, subdivision 5.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 97A.451, subdivision 5, is amended to
1.6 read:

1.7 Subd. 5. **Nonresidents under age 16.** (a) A nonresident under the age of 16 may
1.8 take fish by angling without a license if a parent or guardian has a fishing license. Fish
1.9 taken by a nonresident under the age of 16 without a license must be included in the
1.10 limit of the parent or guardian.

1.11 (b) A nonresident under age 16 may purchase a fishing license at the resident fee
1.12 or be included under a nonresident family license, take fish by angling, and possess
1.13 a limit of fish.

1.14 (c) A nonresident under the age of 16 may purchase a deer hunting license at the
1.15 resident fee according to section 97A.475, subdivision 2, clause (13) or (14).
