1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to education finance; replacing federal comprehensive school reform
1.3 funds that have been reduced; appropriating money.
1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL REFORM.**

1.6 Any school district that received federal comprehensive school reform funds in fiscal
1.7 year 2006 shall be eligible to receive state comprehensive school reform funds under this
1.8 section. For fiscal year 2008, any eligible school district shall receive an amount equal
1.9 to the federal comprehensive school reform funds that the district received in fiscal year
1.10 2006. Any eligible school district must allocate the funds under this section to the school
1.11 that received federal comprehensive school reform funds in fiscal year 2006.

1.12 Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATION.**

1.13 Subdivision 1. **Department of Education.** The sums indicated in this section are
1.14 appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education for the fiscal years
1.15 designated.

1.16 Subd. 2. **Comprehensive school reform.** For the state comprehensive school
1.17 reform program according to section 1:

1.18 \$ 2008

1.19 This is a onetime appropriation.
