Committee Recommendation and Adoption of Report:

To Pass as Amended and re-referred to the Committee on Finance

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to education; extending rulemaking authority of the Board of School
1.3 Administrators; amending Laws 2005, First Special Session chapter 5, article 2,
1.4 section 81, as amended.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Laws 2005, First Special Session chapter 5, article 2, section 81, as amended
1.7 by Laws 2006, chapter 263, article 2, section 20, is amended to read:

1.8 Sec. 81. **BOARD OF SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS; RULEMAKING**
1.9 **AUTHORITY.**

1.10 On or before June 30, ~~2007~~ 2008, the Board of School Administrators may adopt
1.11 rules to reflect the changes in duties, responsibilities, and roles of school administrators
1.12 under sections 121A.035, 121A.037 and 299F.30, and to make technical revisions and
1.13 clarifications to Minnesota Rules, chapter 3512.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

1.15 Sec. 2. **EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS.**

1.16 Any rules adopted by the board of school administrators governing superintendent
1.17 or principal licensure must require that a person applying for a principal or superintendent
1.18 license has at least three years of successful teaching experience gained while holding a
1.19 classroom teaching license valid for the positions in which the applicant taught.

1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
