1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to drivers' licenses; modifying provisions relating to driver's license
1.3 cancellation; amending Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 171.14.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 171.14, is amended to read:

1.6 **171.14 CANCELLATION.**

1.7 (a) The commissioner shall have authority to may cancel any driver's license upon
1.8 determination that (1) the licensee was not entitled to the issuance thereof hereunder, or
1.9 that of the license, (2) the licensee failed to give the required or correct information in
1.10 the application, or (3) the licensee committed any fraud or deceit in making such the
1.11 application. The commissioner may also cancel the driver's license of any, or (4) the
1.12 person who, at the time of the cancellation, would not have been entitled to receive a
1.13 license under the provisions of section 171.04.

1.14 (b) The commissioner shall cancel the driver's license of a person described in
1.15 paragraph (a), clause (3), for 60 days or until the required or correct information has
1.16 been provided, whichever is longer.
