1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 171.05, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 2. **Person less than 18 years of age.** (a) Notwithstanding any provision  
1.7 in subdivision 1 to the contrary, the department may issue an instruction permit to an  
1.8 applicant who is 15, 16, or 17 years of age and who:

1.9 (1) has completed a course of driver education in another state, has a previously  
1.10 issued valid license from another state, or ~~is enrolled in~~ has satisfactorily completed either:

1.11 (i) a public, private, or commercial classroom driver education program that is  
1.12 approved by the commissioner of public safety and ~~that includes classroom and is enrolled~~  
1.13 in behind-the-wheel training; or

1.14 ~~(ii) an approved behind-the-wheel driver education program when the student is~~  
1.15 ~~receiving full-time instruction in a home school within the meaning of sections 120A.22~~  
1.16 ~~and 120A.24, the student is working toward a homeschool diploma, the student's status~~  
1.17 ~~as a homeschool student has been certified by the superintendent of the school district in~~  
1.18 ~~which the student resides, and the student is taking home-classroom driver training with~~  
1.19 ~~classroom materials approved by the commissioner of public safety;~~

1.20 (ii) an Internet-based theory driver education program and is enrolled in  
1.21 behind-the-wheel training;
