1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to public safety; permitting use of 911 data to notify the public of an
1.3 emergency; amending Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 403.07, subdivision 4.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 403.07, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 4. **Use of furnished information.** Names, addresses, and telephone numbers
1.7 provided to a 911 system under subdivision 3 are private data and may be used only ~~for~~
1.8 ~~identifying~~; (1) to identify the location or identity, or both, of a person calling a 911 public
1.9 safety answering point; or (2) by a public safety answering point to notify the public
1.10 of an emergency. The information furnished under subdivision 3 may not be used or
1.11 disclosed by 911 system agencies, their agents, or their employees for any other purpose
1.12 except under a court order.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
