1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to public safety; clarifying authority of Department of Public Safety to  
1.3 disclose driving record information to law enforcement agencies; amending  
1.4 Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 171.12, by adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 171.12, is amended by adding a  
1.7 subdivision to read:

1.8 Subd. 9. **Driving record disclosure to law enforcement.** The commissioner  
1.9 shall also furnish driving records, without charge, to chiefs of police, county sheriffs,  
1.10 prosecuting attorneys, and other law enforcement agencies with the power to arrest.
