A bill for an act

relating to state government; appropriating money to the Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board from money received by the board from other public bodies; appropriating money for decennial comprehensive planning and zoning review; amending Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 15B.17, subdivision 1.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 15B.17, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. **Proposals.** (a) Before a state agency or other public body develops; ~~to submit to the legislature and the governor,~~ a budget proposal or plans for capital improvements within the Capitol Area to submit to the legislature and the governor, it must consult with the board.

(b) The public body must provide enough money for the board's review and planning if the board decides its review and planning services are necessary. Money received by the board under this subdivision is deposited in the special revenue fund and appropriated to the board.

Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATION.**

\$65,000 in fiscal year 2008 is appropriated to the Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board for the decennial expenses related to the board's duties under Minnesota Statutes, section 473.864, subdivisions 1 and 2. Money appropriated in fiscal year 2008 is available until June 30, 2009. This is a onetime appropriation.
