Committee Recommendation and Adoption of Report:

To Pass as Amended and re-referred to the Committee on Finance

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to education; requiring school districts to report student achievement  
1.3 of locally developed academic standards; amending Minnesota Statutes 2006,  
1.4 section 120B.11, subdivision 5.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 120B.11, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 5. **Report.** (a) By October 1 of each year, the school board shall use standard  
1.8 statewide reporting procedures the commissioner develops and adopt a report that includes  
1.9 the following:

1.10 (1) student achievement goals for meeting state academic standards;

1.11 (2) results of local assessment data, and any additional test data;

1.12 (3) evidence of student achievement in subject areas under section 120B.021,

1.13 subdivision 1, for which locally developed academic standards apply and statewide

1.14 assessments are not developed;

1.15 ~~(3)~~ (4) the annual school district improvement plans including staff development  
1.16 goals under section 122A.60;

1.17 ~~(4)~~ (5) information about district and learning site progress in realizing previously  
1.18 adopted improvement plans; and

1.19 ~~(5)~~ (6) the amount and type of revenue attributed to each education site as defined  
1.20 in section 123B.04.

1.21 (b) The school board shall publish the report in the local newspaper with the largest  
1.22 circulation in the district, by mail, or by electronic means such as the district Web site. If  
1.23 electronic means are used, school districts must publish notice of the report in a periodical  
1.24 of general circulation in the district. School districts must make copies of the report

2.1 available to the public on request. The board shall make a copy of the report available to  
2.2 the public for inspection. The board shall send a copy of the report to the commissioner  
2.3 of education by October 15 of each year.

2.4 (c) The title of the report shall contain the name and number of the school district and  
2.5 read "Annual Report on Curriculum, Instruction, and Student Achievement." The report  
2.6 must include at least the following information about advisory committee membership:

2.7 (1) the name of each committee member and the date when that member's term  
2.8 expires;

2.9 (2) the method and criteria the school board uses to select committee members; and

2.10 (3) the date by which a community resident must apply to next serve on the  
2.11 committee.
