The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Health and Human Services

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to health professions; allowing the return of drugs dispensed by
1.3 pharmacies in certain circumstances; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
1.4 Statutes, chapter 151.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[151.56] COUNTY RETURN OF UNUSED DRUGS OR MEDICAL**
1.7 **DEVICES.**

1.8 Notwithstanding Minnesota Rules, part 6800.2700, pharmacies may accept returns
1.9 of unused drugs and medical devices from county jails and juvenile correctional facilities.
1.10 In order to return unused drugs and medical devices, the county jail or juvenile correctional
1.11 facility must have a trained medication technician on hand twenty-four hours a day, seven
1.12 days a week and the medication must be stored in a secured locked storage locker.
