Committee Recommendation and Adoption of Report:

To Pass as Amended and re-referred to the Committee on Finance

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to health professions; allowing the return of drugs dispensed by
1.3 pharmacies in certain circumstances; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
1.4 Statutes, chapter 151.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[151.56] COUNTY RETURN OF UNUSED DRUGS OR MEDICAL**
1.7 **DEVICES.**

1.8 Notwithstanding Minnesota Rules, part 6800.2700, pharmacies may accept returns
1.9 of and redispense unopened, unused drugs and medical devices from county jails and
1.10 juvenile correctional facilities. In order to return unused drugs and medical devices, the
1.11 county jail or juvenile correctional facility must have a correctional employee trained in
1.12 the delivery and storage of medications on hand twenty-four hours a day, seven days a
1.13 week and the medication must be stored in a secured locked storage locker.
