1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to veterans; broadening the eligibility criteria for peace officer reciprocity  
1.3 licensing exam to include certain persons in active military service; amending  
1.4 Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 626.8517.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 626.8517, is amended to read:

1.7 **626.8517 ELIGIBILITY FOR RECIPROCITY EXAMINATION BASED ON**  
1.8 **RELEVANT MILITARY EXPERIENCE.**

1.9 (a) For purposes of this section, "relevant military experience" means five years of  
1.10 active duty military police service.

1.11 (b) A person who has relevant military experience and who is serving honorably  
1.12 or has been honorably discharged from the military is eligible to take the reciprocity  
1.13 examination.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2007.
