1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 62S.265, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.7 Subdivision 1. **Applicability.** ~~(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b),~~ This section
1.8 applies to any long-term care policy or certificate issued in this state ~~on or after January~~
1.9 ~~1, 2002,~~ under this chapter or sections 62A.46 to 62A.56.

1.10 ~~(b) For certificates issued on or after July 1, 2001, under a group long-term care~~
1.11 ~~insurance policy as defined in section 62S.01, subdivision 15, issued under this chapter,~~
1.12 ~~that was in force on July 1, 2001, this section applies on the policy anniversary following~~
1.13 ~~June 30, 2002.~~

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
