The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Labor

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to commerce; alcohol sales; defining a "person of questionable character"
1.3 to include any person whose driver's license restricts the person from consuming
1.4 any alcohol at any time.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **QUESTIONABLE CHARACTER.**

1.7 For purposes of Minnesota Rules, part 7515.0590, the term "person of questionable
1.8 character" includes any person whose driver's license contains the restriction that the
1.9 person may not drink alcohol at any time.

1.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2007, and applies to the
1.11 serving or provision of alcohol on or after that date.
