1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 proposing an amendment to the Minnesota Constitution, by adding a section to
1.3 article XIII; establishing there is no constitutional right to abortion.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSED.**

1.6 An amendment to the Minnesota Constitution is proposed to the people. If the
1.7 amendment is adopted, a section will be added to article XIII, to read:

1.8 Sec. 13. Nothing in this constitution may be construed to create a right to abortion.

1.9 Sec. 2. **SUBMISSION TO VOTERS.**

1.10 The proposed amendment must be submitted to the people at the 2008 general
1.11 election. The question submitted shall be:

1.12 "Shall the Minnesota Constitution be amended to provide that there is no
1.13 constitutional right to abortion?

1.14 Yes
1.15 No"
