The bill was read for the first time and Interim introduction, referred to Finance

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to capital improvements; appropriating money for the Cold Spring  
1.3 downtown riverfront redevelopment project; authorizing the sale and issuance of  
1.4 state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; COLD SPRING DOWNTOWN RIVERFRONT**  
1.7 **REDEVELOPMENT.**

1.8 \$2,118,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of  
1.9 economic development for a grant to the city of Cold Spring to acquire land for, and  
1.10 to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip public facilities located in the city  
1.11 of Cold Spring, including: expanded docking facilities; a community center housing  
1.12 the Cold Spring Public Library, the Cold Spring History Museum, and a senior center;  
1.13 a riverfront promenade connecting Lions Park to Frogtown Park; a regional trail head  
1.14 park and shelter; and a canoe portage route.

1.15 Sec. 2. **BOND SALE.**

1.16 To provide the money appropriated in section 1 from the bond proceeds fund,  
1.17 the commissioner of finance shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to  
1.18 \$2,118,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota  
1.19 Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XI,  
1.20 sections 4 to 7.

1.21 Sec. 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

1.22 Sections 1 and 2 are effective the day following final enactment.
