1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to game and fish; permitting the use of two angling lines; amending
1.3 Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 97C.315, subdivision 1.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 97C.315, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Lines.** An angler may not use ~~more than one line except:~~
1.7 ~~(1) two lines may be used to take fish through the ice; and~~
1.8 ~~(2) the commissioner may, by rule, authorize the use of two lines in areas designated~~
1.9 ~~by the commissioner in Lake Superior.~~
