1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Laws 2003, First Special Session chapter 20, article 1, section 12,
1.8 subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.9 Subd. 3. **Wastewater Infrastructure Funding**
1.10 **Program** 15,000,000

1.11 To the public facilities authority for grants to
1.12 eligible municipalities under the wastewater
1.13 infrastructure program established in
1.14 Minnesota Statutes, section 446A.072.

1.15 To the greatest practical extent, the authority
1.16 should use the grants for projects on the
1.17 2002 project priority list in priority order to
1.18 qualified applicants that submit plans and
1.19 specifications to the pollution control agency
1.20 or receive a funding commitment from
1.21 USDA rural development before December
1.22 1, 2003.

1.23 \$1,500,000 is for grants to the ~~Larsmont~~
1.24 ~~portion of the Knife River-Larsmont~~

2.1 Duluth/North Shore sanitary district. This
2.2 appropriation must be used to reduce the
2.3 amount of the municipality's loan from the
2.4 water pollution revolving fund that exceeds
2.5 five percent of the market value of the
2.6 properties in the project service area. This
2.7 appropriation is in addition to grants from
2.8 other appropriations.

2.10 Section 1 is effective the day following final enactment.
