The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to transportation; appropriating money for Trunk Highway 8
1.3 improvements in the city of Lindstrom; authorizing sale of trunk highway bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **TRUNK HIGHWAY 8 IMPROVEMENTS; LINDSTROM.**

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$830,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.7 account in the trunk highway fund to the commissioner of transportation for improvements
1.8 to marked Trunk Highway 8 in Lindstrom. Of this amount, \$780,000 is to design and
1.9 construct a replacement bridge for marked Trunk Highway 8 over the water channel
1.10 between South and North Lindstrom Lakes in Lindstrom, and \$50,000 is to dredge the
1.11 channel under a new bridge for marked Trunk Highway 8 between South and North
1.12 Lindstrom Lakes in Lindstrom. This appropriation is not available until the commissioner
1.13 of finance determines that at least an equal amount is committed to the project from
1.14 nonstate sources.

1.15 Subd. 2. **Bond sale authorization.** To provide the money appropriated in
1.16 subdivision 1 from the bond proceeds account in the trunk highway fund, the commissioner
1.17 of finance shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$830,000 in the
1.18 manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections
1.19 167.50 to 167.52, and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XIV, section 11, at the times
1.20 and in the amounts requested by the commissioner of transportation. The proceeds of the
1.21 bonds, except accrued interest and any premium received on the sale of the bonds, must be
1.22 credited to the bond proceeds account in the trunk highway fund.

1.23 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
