1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **MEETINGS AND EVENTS AFTER 6:00 P.M. ON MARCH 4, 2008.**

1.6 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, sections 202A.14 and 202A.19, and because
1.7 the major political parties' caucus was held on February 5, 2008, a public entity covered
1.8 by Minnesota Statutes, section 202A.19, may hold a meeting or event after 6:00 p.m.
1.9 on March 4, 2008.

1.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective March 1, 2008.
