The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital improvements; appropriating money for Cuyuna State
1.3 Recreation Area; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION.**

1.6 \$2,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of
1.7 natural resources to construct a new access road, rustic campground, support facilities
1.8 for biking and scuba activities, and for other improvements of a capital nature at the
1.9 Cuyuna State Recreation Area.

1.10 This appropriation includes \$150,000 for a match to federal funds, for development
1.11 of a natural surface, minimal impact trail to be used for mountain biking and other
1.12 compatible uses.

1.13 Sec. 2. **BOND SALE.**

1.14 To provide the money appropriated in section 1 from the bond proceeds fund,
1.15 the commissioner of finance shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to
1.16 \$2,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota
1.17 Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XI,
1.18 sections 4 to 7.

1.19 Sec. 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

1.20 Sections 1 and 2 are effective the day following final enactment.
