The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Transportation Finance Division

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to motor vehicles; modifying provisions governing requirement and use  
1.3 of USDOT carrier numbers; amending Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 168.185.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 168.185, is amended to read:

1.6 **168.185 USDOT NUMBERS.**

1.7 (a) Except as provided in paragraph (e), an owner of a truck or truck-tractor having a  
1.8 gross vehicle weight of more than 10,000 pounds, as defined in section 169.01, subdivision  
1.9 46, ~~other than a farm truck that is not used in interstate commerce~~, shall report to the  
1.10 ~~registrar~~ commissioner at the time of registration its USDOT carrier number. A person  
1.11 subject to this paragraph who does not have a USDOT number shall apply for the number  
1.12 at the time of registration by completing a form MCS-150 Motor Carrier Identification  
1.13 Report, issued by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, or comparable  
1.14 document as determined by the ~~registrar~~ commissioner. The ~~registrar~~ commissioner shall  
1.15 not assign a USDOT carrier number to a vehicle owner who is not subject to this paragraph.

1.16 (b) Assigned USDOT numbers need not be displayed on the outside of the  
1.17 vehicle, but must be made available upon request of an authorized agent of the ~~registrar~~  
1.18 commissioner, peace officer, other employees of the State Patrol authorized in chapter  
1.19 299D, or employees of the Minnesota Department of Transportation. The vehicle owner  
1.20 shall notify the ~~registrar~~ commissioner if there is a change to the owner's USDOT number.

1.21 (c) If an owner fails to report or apply for a USDOT number, the ~~registrar~~  
1.22 commissioner shall suspend the owner's registration.

1.23 (d) ~~Until October 1, 2003, paragraphs (a) to (c) do not apply to an agricultural~~  
1.24 ~~fertilizer or agricultural chemical retailer while exclusively engaged in delivering fertilizer~~

2.1 ~~or agricultural chemicals to a farmer for on-farm use.~~ This section does not apply to  
2.2 (1) a farm truck that is not used in interstate commerce, (2) a vehicle that is not used  
2.3 in intrastate commerce or interstate commerce, or (3) a vehicle that is owned and used  
2.4 solely in the transaction of official business by the federal government, the state, or any  
2.5 political subdivision.
