Committee Recommendation and Adoption of Report:

To Pass and re-referred to the Committee on Finance

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to public safety; controlled substances; adding *Salvia divinorum* to
1.3 schedule IV of the controlled substance schedules; amending Minnesota Statutes
1.4 2006, section 152.02, subdivision 5.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 152.02, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 5. **Schedule IV.** The following items are listed in Schedule IV: Barbitol;
1.8 Butorphanol; Carisoprodol; Chloral betaine; Chloral hydrate; Chlordiazepoxide;
1.9 Clonazepam; Clorazepate; Diazepam; Diethylpropion; Ethchlorvynol; Ethinamate;
1.10 Fenfluramine; Flurazepam; Mebutamate; Methohexital; Meprobamate except when in
1.11 combination with the following drugs in the following or lower concentrations: conjugated
1.12 estrogens, 0.4 mg; tridihexethyl chloride, 25mg; pentaerythritol tetranitrate, 20 mg;
1.13 Methylphenobarbital; Oxazepam; Paraldehyde; Pemoline; Petrichloral; Phenobarbital;
1.14 ~~and~~ Phentermine; and Salvia divinorum.

1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2008, and applies to crimes
1.16 committed on or after that date.
