1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to horse racing; providing for certain occupational licenses; amending
1.3 Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 240.08, by adding a subdivision.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 240.08, is amended by adding a
1.6 subdivision to read:

1.7 Subd. 2a. **Certain occupational licenses.** The commission may issue a license to
1.8 an applicant otherwise disqualified pursuant to section 240.08, subdivision 2, clause
1.9 (b), for an occupation that does not involve gaming operations, security, surveillance, or
1.10 the handling of pari-mutuel or card club revenues, provided that the applicant has not
1.11 been convicted of a felony or a crime involving fraud or misrepresentation within ten
1.12 years of application, has never been convicted of a gambling-related offense, does not
1.13 have a felony charge pending, has been discharged from any supervision related to the
1.14 disqualifying offense for a period of at least five years and is not required to register
1.15 pursuant to section 243.166.
