1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to retirement; amending the correctional state employees retirement  
1.3 plan; adding two employment positions to retirement plan coverage; amending  
1.4 Minnesota Statutes 2007 Supplement, section 352.91, subdivision 3d.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2007 Supplement, section 352.91, subdivision 3d,  
1.7 is amended to read:

1.8 Subd. 3d. **Other correctional personnel.** (a) "Covered correctional service" means  
1.9 service by a state employee in one of the employment positions at a correctional facility or  
1.10 at the Minnesota Security Hospital specified in paragraph (b) if at least 75 percent of the  
1.11 employee's working time is spent in direct contact with inmates or patients and the fact of  
1.12 this direct contact is certified to the executive director by the appropriate commissioner.

1.13 (b) The employment positions are ~~as follows~~:

1.15 (2) central services administrative specialist, intermediate;

1.16 (3) central services administrative specialist, principal;

1.17 (4) chaplain;

1.18 (5) chief cook;

1.22 (9) corrections program therapist 2;

1.23 (10) corrections program therapist 3;

- 2.2            (13) corrections transitions program coordinator;
- 2.3            (14) corrections security caseworker;
- 2.4            (15) corrections security caseworker career;

- 2.7            (18) dentist;
- 2.8            (19) electrician supervisor;

2.28            Sec. 2. **COVERAGE TRANSFER DATES.**

2.29            (a) The coverage transfer under Minnesota Statutes, section 352.91, subdivision 3d,  
 2.30            paragraph (b), clause (20), also covers employment in that position after December 11,  
 2.31            2007, for purposes of Minnesota Statutes, section 352.955, subdivisions 1, 3, 4, 5, and 6.

2.32            (b) The coverage change under Minnesota Statutes, section 352.91, subdivision 3d,  
 2.33            paragraph (b), clause (25), is prospective only.

2.34            **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
