

2.1 (5) causes the death of a minor while committing child abuse, when the perpetrator
 2.2 has engaged in ~~a past pattern~~ previous incidents of child abuse upon a child and the death
 2.3 occurs under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life;

2.4 (6) causes the death of a human being while committing domestic abuse, when
 2.5 the perpetrator has engaged in ~~a past pattern~~ previous incidents of domestic abuse upon
 2.6 the victim or upon another family or household member and the death occurs under
 2.7 circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life; or

2.8 (7) causes the death of a human being while committing, conspiring to commit, or
 2.9 attempting to commit a felony crime to further terrorism and the death occurs under
 2.10 circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life.

2.11 (b) For purposes of paragraph (a), clause (5);:

2.12 (1) "child abuse" means an act committed against a minor victim that constitutes a
 2.13 violation of the following laws of this state or any similar laws of the United States or any
 2.14 other state: section 609.221; 609.222; 609.223; 609.224; 609.2242; 609.342; 609.343;
 2.15 609.344; 609.345; 609.377; 609.378; or 609.713; and

2.16 (2) "previous incidents of child abuse" means two or more acts of child abuse
 2.17 occurring at any time before the death of the victim, proved by direct or circumstantial
 2.18 evidence, whether or not resulting in charges, convictions, or juvenile findings or
 2.19 adjudications.

2.20 (c) For purposes of paragraph (a), clause (6);:

2.21 (1) "domestic abuse" means an act that:

2.22 ~~(1)~~ (i) constitutes a violation of section 518B.01, subdivisions 14 and 22; 609.221;
 2.23 609.222; 609.223; 609.224; 609.2242; 609.2247; 609.342; 609.343; 609.344;
 2.24 609.345; 609.713; 609.749, subdivisions 3, 4, and 5; or any similar laws of the United
 2.25 States or any other state; and

2.26 ~~(2)~~ (ii) is committed against the victim who is a family or household member as
 2.27 defined in section 518B.01, subdivision 2, paragraph (b); and

2.28 (2) "previous incidents of domestic abuse" means two or more acts of domestic
 2.29 abuse occurring at any time before the death of the victim, proved by direct or
 2.30 circumstantial evidence, whether or not resulting in charges, convictions, juvenile
 2.31 findings, or adjudications.

2.32 (d) For purposes of paragraph (a), clause (7), "further terrorism" has the meaning
 2.33 given in section 609.714, subdivision 1.

2.34 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2008, and applies to crimes
 2.35 committed on or after that date.
