1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2007 Supplement, section 629.30, subdivision 2, is
1.7 amended to read:

1.8 Subd. 2. **Who may arrest.** An arrest may be made:

1.9 (1) by a peace officer under a warrant;

1.10 (2) by a peace officer without a warrant;

1.11 (3) by an officer in the United States Customs and Border Protection or ~~the United~~
1.12 ~~States Citizenship and Immigration Services~~ Immigration and Customs Enforcement
1.13 without a warrant;

1.14 (4) by a private person.

1.15 A private person shall aid a peace officer in executing a warrant when requested to
1.16 do so by the officer.
