Committee Recommendation and Adoption of Report:

To Pass as Amended and re-referred to the Committee on Public Safety and Civil Justice

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to natural resources; prohibiting the enforcement of federal laws by state
1.3 employees in the state's navigable waters of Voyageurs National Park; proposing
1.4 coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 84B.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[84B.062] ENFORCEMENT OF FEDERAL LAWS.**

1.7 A state employee shall not enforce federal laws pertaining to the use of all-terrain
1.8 vehicles, snowmobiles, or aircraft in the navigable waters within Voyageurs National Park
1.9 under the state's jurisdiction as described in section 84B.061.
