1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to community education; modifying adults with disabilities revenue;  
1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 124D.56, subdivisions 1, 2, 3; Laws  
1.4 2007, chapter 146, article 9, section 17, subdivision 9.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 124D.56, subdivision 1, is amended to  
1.7 read:

1.8 Subdivision 1. **Revenue amount.** A district that is eligible according to section  
1.9 124D.20, subdivision 2, may receive revenue for a program for adults with disabilities.  
1.10 Revenue for the program for adults with disabilities for a district or a group of districts  
1.11 equals the lesser of:

- 1.12 (1) the actual expenditures for approved programs and budgets; or
- 1.13 (2) ~~\$60,000~~ \$75,000.

1.14 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 124D.56, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.15 Subd. 2. **Aid.** Program aid for adults with disabilities equals the lesser of:  
1.16 (1) one-half of the actual expenditures for approved programs and budgets; or  
1.17 (2) ~~\$30,000~~ \$45,000.

1.18 Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 124D.56, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.19 Subd. 3. **Levy.** A district may levy for a program for adults with disabilities an  
1.20 amount up to ~~the amount designated in subdivision 2~~ \$30,000. In the case of a program  
1.21 offered by a group of districts, the levy amount must be apportioned among the districts  
1.22 according to the agreement submitted to the department.

2.1 Sec. 4. Laws 2007, chapter 146, article 9, section 17, subdivision 9, is amended to read:

2.2 Subd. 9. **Adults with disabilities program aid.** For adults with disabilities  
2.3 programs under Minnesota Statutes, section 124D.56:

2.6 \$ 2,321,000 ..... 2009

2.7 The 2008 appropriation includes \$71,000 for 2007 and \$639,000 for 2008.

2.8 The 2009 appropriation includes \$71,000 for 2008 and ~~\$639,000~~ \$2,250,000 for  
2.9 2009.

2.10 School districts operating existing adults with disabilities programs that are not fully  
2.11 funded shall receive full funding for the program beginning in fiscal year 2008 before the  
2.12 commissioner awards grants to other districts.
