1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 18D.305, subdivision 2, is amended to
1.7 read:

1.8 Subd. 2. **Revocation and suspension.** (a) The commissioner may, after written
1.9 notice and hearing, revoke, suspend, or refuse to grant or renew a registration, permit,
1.10 license, or certification if a person violates a provision of this chapter or has a history
1.11 within the last three years of violations of this chapter.

1.12 (b) The commissioner may refuse to accept an application for a registration, permit,
1.13 license, or certification, and may revoke or suspend a previously issued registration,
1.14 permit, license, or certification of a person from another state if that person has:

1.15 (1) had a registration, permit, license, or certification denied, revoked, or suspended
1.16 by another state for an offense reasonably related to the requirements, qualifications, or
1.17 duties of a registration, permit, license, or certification issued under chapter 18B or 18C; or

1.18 (2) been convicted of a violation, had a history of violations, or been subject to a
1.19 final order imposing civil penalties authorized under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide
1.20 and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended.
