The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to game and fish; requiring certain meetings between the Department
1.3 of Natural Resources, the Ojibwe tribes, and the Great Lakes Indian Fish and
1.4 Wildlife Commission to be subject to the open meeting law; proposing coding
1.5 for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 97A.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. **[97A.162] MEETINGS SUBJECT TO OPEN MEETING LAW.**

1.8 Meetings between the Department of Natural Resources, the eight Ojibwe tribes,
1.9 and the Great Lakes Indian Fish and Wildlife Commission regarding 1837 treaty rights
1.10 shall be open to the public and subject to the open meeting provisions under chapter 13D.
