1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to environment; providing for publication of adjustments to costs  
1.3 announced by the Petroleum Tank Release Compensation Board; amending  
1.4 Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 115C.07, subdivision 3.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 115C.07, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 3. **Rules.** (a) The board shall adopt rules regarding its practices and  
1.8 procedures, the form and procedure for applications for compensation from the fund,  
1.9 procedures for investigation of claims and specifying the costs that are eligible for  
1.10 reimbursement from the fund.

1.11 (b) The board may adopt rules requiring certification of environmental consultants.

1.12 (c) The board may adopt other rules necessary to implement this chapter.

1.13 (d) The board may use section 14.389 to adopt rules specifying the competitive  
1.14 bidding requirements for consultant services proposals.

1.15 (e) The board may use section 14.389 to adopt rules specifying the written proposal  
1.16 and invoice requirements for consultant services.

1.17 (f) Upon written notification from the board of the adjusted dollar amounts  
1.18 determined pursuant to Minnesota Rules, parts 2890.1900, item D, and 2890.3900, item D,  
1.19 the revisor of statutes must adjust the dollar amounts in Minnesota Rules, parts 2890.1300  
1.20 to 2890.1600, 2890.2600, 2890.2800 to 2890.3100, and 2890.3300 to 2890.3800, to reflect  
1.21 the adjustments announced and published by the board.

1.22 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for changes announced in 2006  
1.23 and thereafter.
