1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to the city of Austin; authorizing expenditures of tax increments for
1.3 certain purposes.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **CITY OF AUSTIN; TAX INCREMENT FINANCING AUTHORITY.**

1.6 Notwithstanding the requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 469.1763,
1.7 subdivision 3, that activities must be undertaken within a five-year period from the date of
1.8 certification of tax increment financing district and notwithstanding the provisions of any
1.9 other law, the governing body of the city of Austin may use tax increments from its Tax
1.10 Increment Financing District No. 9 to reimburse the city's housing and redevelopment
1.11 authority for money spent disposing of soils and debris in the tax increment financing
1.12 district, as required by the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective upon compliance by the governing
1.14 body of the city of Austin with the requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021.
