1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **EXPEDITED PROCESS; SPECIFIC LEARNING DISABILITIES**
1.7 **RULE.**

1.8 The commissioner of education may use the expedited process under Minnesota
1.9 Statutes, section 14.389, to conform Minnesota Rules, part 3525.1341, to new federal
1.10 requirements on specific learning disabilities under Public Law 108-446, sections 602(30)
1.11 and 614(b)(6), the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004,
1.12 and its implementing regulations.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

1.14 Sec. 2. **REPEALER.**

1.15 Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 121A.67, and Laws 2006, chapter 263, article 3,
1.16 section 16, are repealed.
