1.2 relating to crime; adding criminal convictions that lead to enhancement of fifth
1.3 degree criminal sexual conduct; amending Minnesota Statutes 2006, section
1.4 609.3451, subdivision 3.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 609.3451, subdivision 3, is amended to
1.7 read:

1.8 Subd. 3. **Felony.** A person is guilty of a felony and may be sentenced to
1.9 imprisonment for not more than five years or to payment of a fine of not more than
1.10 \$10,000, or both, if the person violates ~~subdivision 1, clause (2),~~ this section after having
1.11 been previously convicted of or adjudicated delinquent for violating ~~subdivision 1,~~
1.12 ~~clause (2)~~ this section; section sections 609.342 to 609.345; 609.3453; 609.352; 617.23,
1.13 subdivision 2, clause (1) or 3; 617.246; 617.247; or a statute from another state in
1.14 conformity with ~~subdivision 1, clause (2), or section 617.23, subdivision 2, clause (1)~~ a
1.15 crime listed under this subdivision.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2008, and applies to crimes
1.17 committed on or after that date.
