1.6	Section 1. MCLEOD WEST SCHOOL DISTRICT; FUNDING BONDS.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Reorganization operating debt determined. Independent School
1.8	District No. 2887, McLeod West, must estimate its reorganization operating debt
1.9	according to Minnesota Statutes, section 123B.82, and submit that amount to the
1.10	commissioner of education for approval.
1.11	Subd. 2. Bond sale. Independent School District No. 2887, McLeod West, may
1.12	issue general obligation bonds without an election under Minnesota Statutes, chapter
1.13	475, in an amount not to exceed the reorganization operating debt approved by the
1.14	commissioner of education under subdivision 1. The bonds must be repaid within six
1.15	years of issuance.
1.16	Subd. 3. Repayment. The bonded debt issued under this section remains payable
