Referred by Chair to Local Government Division.

March 15, 2010

Returned to the Committee on State and Local Government Operations Reform, Technology and Elections as Amended.

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to youth development; authorizing municipalities to raise and spend
1.3 money on 4-H; requiring a University of Minnesota Extension Service policy;
1.4 proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 38.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[38.345] APPROPRIATIONS BY MUNICIPALITIES.**

1.7 The council of any city and the board of supervisors of any town may incur expenses
1.8 and spend money for county extension work, as provided in sections 38.33 to 38.38.

1.9 Sec. 2. **EXTENSION POLICY; 4-H FEES.**

1.10 The Extension Service of the University of Minnesota shall adopt a policy
1.11 authorizing participant fees imposed on a 4-H program in a county to be used for the costs
1.12 of providing a 4-H educator in that county.
