1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to game and fish; permitting use of two angling lines; amending  
1.3 Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 97C.315, subdivision 1.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 97C.315, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Lines.** An angler may not use more than one line except:  
1.7 (1) two lines may be used to take fish through the ice; and  
1.8 (2) the commissioner may, by rule, authorize the use of two lines in areas designated  
1.9 by the commissioner in Lake Superior.
