1.8	Subdivision 1. Authorization. Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section
1.9	469.176, subdivision 1c, the St. Louis Park economic development authority may collect
1.10	and expend tax increments from the Excelsior Boulevard Redevelopment Project and Oak
1.11	Park Village tax increment financing districts (Hennepin county project numbers 1300
1.12	and 1301, respectively) located within the city of St. Louis Park, after April 1, 2001, for
1.13	eligible activities within the redevelopment area. The authority under this section expires
1.14	August 1, 2009, with respect to the Oak Park Village District, and expires December 31,
