1.7	fund to the Metropolitan Council for a grant to Ramsey County to construct a
1.8	ten-foot-wide hard surface and boardwalk pedestrian and bicycle trail in Keller Regional
1.9	Park from the Trunk Highway 61 trail underpass at Lower Keller picnic area, north to the

1.11	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the
1.12	bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of finance shall sell and issue bonds of the state in
